

# **Minutes of District Indemnity subcommittee**

## **Meeting held on dated 24.06.2020.**

A Meeting of District Indemnity subcommittee was held on 24.06.2020 under the chairmanship of Civil Surgeon, Panchkula. Attendance list of the participants is attached. Following points were discussed:-

### **1. Compensation to sterilization failure cases**

Dy. Civil Surgeon (FW) informed to all the members that the following sterilization failure cases have been received from GH-6 , CHC Kalka and CHC Raipurrani.

- b) **Smt. Neha W/o Rakesh**
- c) **Smt. Neelam w/o Raman**
- d) **Smt. Meena w/o Dalip**
- e) **Smt. Rani w/o Nanhe**
- f) **Smt. Anju w/o Dalip Singh**

All the documents are completed as per the checklist requirement of documents for claim of sterilization failure case under Family Planning Indemnity Scheme. The members verified all the documents and approved the file for compensation to each beneficiary of Rs. 60,000/- (from State Budget and NHM Budget Head).

**2. Reduction of failure rate:-** Dy. Civil Surgeon (FW) informed to all the members that 6 sterilization failure cases have been reported in the financial year of 2020-2021 which increases the failure rate. The members advised that individual list of operating Gynaecologist and Surgeon will be prepared regarding whose cases have been reported and the doctor whom cases are maximum, an orientation and refresher training can be done to reduce the failure rate.

**3. Reply to Legal Notices:** Dy. Civil Surgeon (FW) informed to all the members that 2 legal notices for the compensation of sterilization failure cases have been received. One legal notice of Ms. Jyoti W/o Manoj Mehra R/o Village Ghatiwala, Bitna Road, Pinjore. And second legal notice of Ms. Reetu W/o Sh. Sonu V.P.O Thakur Pura (Kalalti), Tehsil Barara, Distt. Ambala. The reply has been sent to both the concerned advocates.

**4. Hon'ble Supreme Court Directives-** Dy. Civil Surgeon (FW) informed to all the members and incharges of the operating centers to adhere to the directives issued by Hon'ble Supreme Court and asked for the regular compliance as per the directives so that the reports can be send to the Director (FW) well in time.

The meeting concluded with a vote of thanks and requested that efforts will be taken by all the participants to further improve the performance of Family Welfare programme.
