Subject: - Payment to Contractual Staff of NHM & other beneficiaries (ASHAs, JSY etc) through DBT/Aadhaar Linked Scheme.

Please refer on the subject cited above..

I It is to inform you that as per strict instructions from Ministry of Health & Family Welfare, Govt of India from time to time it was emphasized that the payment to Contractual Staff of NHM & other beneficiaries (ASHA/JSY Beneficiaries/Family Planning beneficiaries) are to be made only through Direct benefit Transfer mode i.e in the bank account of beneficiaries having Aadhaar linked. The benefit of Aadhaar linked disbursement are obvious in terms of transparency and accountability and 100 % target precision.

Since direct benefit transfer (DBT) is a high priority area and is being reviewed at the top most level in the government, I request you to make all efforts to ensure that all the payments to beneficiaries under NHM Programme be done only in DBT mode for which it must be ensured that the Aadhaar no. of the beneficiary be seeded with his/ her bank a/cs so that ASHA workers and contractual staff do not encounter any difficulty in Aadhaar enabled payments . Further, correct Aadhaar no of all ASHA worker, beneficiaries and contractual employee's be seeded on Public Finance Management System (PFMS) portal. The work of seeding of aadhaar no with bank a/cs and seeding of Aadhaar no on PFMS Portal be completed by **31st Oct 2016**.

Seeding of Aadhaar & bank Account is a one time exercise and can easily be completed under a drive, considering the fact that majority of ASHAs and employees are already getting payment directly into their bank A/c. In case, an ASHA Worker, employee does not have Aadhaar, they may be facilitated to get enrolled for Aadhaar seeded in the bank a/c.

To clarify the concept of DBT and PFMS a guideline has been prepared and is annexed at Annexure 'A' for information and taking necessary action.

II Further it is observed that under various Disease control programme (RNTCP,NLEP,NBCP,IDSP & NVBDCP), Ayush and NCD etc, generally made payments through simple bank transfer(NEFT/RTGS) and PFMS portal is not being used which is viewed seriously as it is against the Govt of India instructions and also not lead to capture real time expenditure.

It is therefore advised to issue strict instructions to these programme officers for use of PFMS portal only for making any payments from NHM funds through DBT mode.
