Subject: Implementation of Direct Benefit Transfer on Family Planning Schemes.

I am directed to invite your attentions to this office letter no. NRHM/DFA/2014-15/3109-26, NHM/PFMS/2015-16/9797-17 dated 28/04/2014 & 05/05/2015 vide which starting of Fund Transfer/Expenditure filing, disbursement of Incentive to JSY/Asha beneficiary's and registration of Functional Health Facilities on Public Financial Management System (formerly CPSMS) was impressed upon and this office continued to issue instructions from time to time in this regard and lastly vide letter dated 15/02/2016 of DBT (PFMS) Portal System.

Ministry of Health & Family Welfare, GOI, New Delhi vide DO letter no. Y.1103/1/2016-FP dated 29/02/2016 (copy enclosed) has directed for covering following Family Planning Schemes under Direct Benefit Transfer of PFMS.

1. Enhanced Compensation Scheme for Sterilization (Male/Female).
2. PPIUCD Incentive Scheme.
3. ESB(Ensuring Space of Births) Scheme.
4. Family Planning Indemnity Scheme (FPIS) wherein payments are made in three conditions namely:-
 - a. Death within 7 days after surgery (Tubectomy/Vasectomy).
 - b. Death after 7 -30 days after surgery (Tubectomy/Vasectomy).
 - c. Failure
 - d. Complications

The payment under First Component i.e (4-a-1) to avoid above potential law and order situations, the payment of INR 50,000/- may be made in cash to the legal dependant (as per the Scheme) immediately (if no Saving accounts/Jan Dhan Accounts are there) and the balance INR 1,50,000/- can be paid through DBT after it is established that death is attributable to sterilization operation. The Implementation of above DBT Mechanism under Family Planning Schemes must be accorded priority using SOP (enclosed).

“Account should be opened in the Name of Beneficiary. Relative or husband account not allowed for disbursement of Family Planning Scheme Incentive”

You are requested to accord top priority for implementation of DBT under Family Planning Schemes under initiation of this office.
