**Subject:- Promoting cashless transactions in all Health Institution.**

Please refer to this office letter no. NHM/Acctts./2016-17/27495-515 dated 08.12.2016 vide which it was directed to ensure cashless transactions for all purposes in all subordinate Health institutions in the districts.

The aim was to go cashless and stop the menace of black money and corruption in the system. The Govt. of Haryana has issued instructions through its various circulars for adopting digital methods for cashless transactions. A meeting has recently been held under the chairmanship of Additional Chief Secretary Health where various modes for digitalization and complete elimination of cash transaction in our Health Facilities were discussed. It has been decided that

**Payments:**

- Cashless payments may be done to all beneficiaries, employees, Asha's, contractors, vendors, etc, etc.
- The contingency payments even in smaller denominations may be done digitally using electronics modes including advances given for any purpose as already desired vide this office letter dated 08.12.2016 referred above.

**Receipts:**

- All health facilities should be fully geared up to receive fees and user charges in a digital manner for which necessary steps be taken immediately.

You are requested to follow the foresaid guidelines and instructions issued by this office vide letter dated 08.12.2016 referred above in its letter and spirit. An early arrangements may also be made to install swipe machines and upload e-wallets on the mobiles of the persons posted at cash counters. The action taken and progress made in this regard may be shared with this office.
