



Sir/Madam,

Kindly refer to the subject noted above.

The historic decision of Government of India to withdraw the Bank Notes of Rs 500/- and 1000/- denomination (Now called as Specified Bank Notes) provides an opportunity to discourage cash transactions and move towards cashless transactions to curb the menace of black money and corruption in the system. Therefore, it has been decided by the Government of Haryana to promote cashless transactions which also results in ease of doing business. Hence, all Government Departments are advised to take all requisite steps to facilitate the cashless transactions in the State. To achieve this objective, all Departments / Corporations / Boards are directed to install swipe machines and provide necessary infrastructure to facilitate the common man including employees to make payments towards Government dues through electronics mediums like debit / credit cards specially the Rupay cards, etc. without any difficulty.

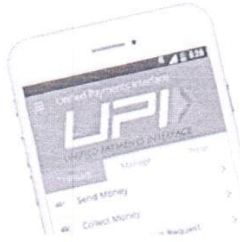

Every bank has its own mobile app – so it's now possible to transact on your smart phones

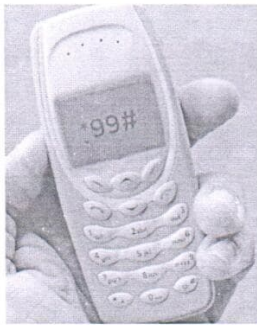
- Register your mobile number in the Bank or ATM

- Choose "Fund Transfer-MMID" option
- Enter the payee's mobile number and MMID
- Enter the amount and your MPIN, leave a space and enter the last 4 digits of your account number
- ✔ You have just transferred your money!



e-Wallet

It is as easy as sending photos through your phone!
With Mobile or Computer:

- Download a wallet like SBI Buddy
- Register with your mobile number
- Link this with your debit or credit card or through net banking
- ✔ Your phone is now your Wallet!

Aadhaar Enabled Payment System
