The Term of Reference (TOR) of the Task force Would be to :-

1. Review the trends in following health indicators of Haryana:-
 - Maternal Mortality Rate
 - Under 5 Mortality Rate (U5MR), Child, Infant, Neonatal Mortality Rate and other related Mortality indicators
 - TFR(Total Fertility Rate and CPR (Couple Protection Rate)
 - Gender Ratio
 - Anaemia Prevalence
 - Prevalence of Malnutrition
2. Deliberate on the strategies and programmes which have been in place for the last five years to improve the important health indicators.
3. Make recommendations on the strategic interventions to be made in the next five years (plan period) to improve the health indicators. It would lay down the road map and the achievable targets for the next five years.
4. Recommendations and future strategies would include specifically the Maternal & Child Health Programme, the immunization programme the programme to reduce anaemia and mal nutrition and mal nutrition and programme on adverse gender ratio.
5. Assess the trends of nutrition/under nutrition and anaemia in the State and make recommendations on strategic approach/intervention required to improve the nutritional status.
6. Recommendations would also include specific actions required to be taken by various departments and measures for improvement of inter sectoral coordination.
7. The task force will take into account both rural and urban scenarios, the regional, the socio economic and cultural factors within the State while making recommendations.
8. Take up any other issue, co-opt any person, group or institutions and appoint a subgroup/working group in order to complete its work as per discussion of the chairperson of the Task Force.
9. The Task Force would make its recommendation four months after its constitution.
10. The budget for the expenditure of committee would be incurred from the budget of HSHRC-NRHM. The non-Govt. Members who attend meetings or help in preparation of report would be allowed IInd AC train fare or Air fare along with DA as admissible to Class 1 Officer of Government of Haryana.


